*From unbelief **to** believing.

*From the worlds love **to** knowing His love.

*From the worlds joy **to** having His joy.

*From having no hope **to** having our hope in Him.

*From being alienated **to** being citizens. That at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world; but now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ. Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints, and of the household of God. Eph.2:12, 13, 19.

*From orphans **to** adoption. For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba Father. **Rom. 8:15.**

*From children **to** Joint Heirs of a King! And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together. **Rom. 8:17.**

*From carnally minded **to** Spiritually minded. For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. **Rom. 8:6.**

*From the temporal **to** the eternal.

*From being deaf **to** hearing. **Matt.13:16**

*From being blind **to** having sight. Blessed are your eyes, for they see: and your ears, for they hear. **Matt.13:16**

*From ignorance **to** wisdom.

*From barren **to** fruitful.

*From bondage **to** liberty. The creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God. **Rom. 8:21.**

*From corruption **to** incorruption. So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown in corruption; it is raised in incorruption. It is sown in dishonor; it is raised in glory: It is sown in weakness; it is raised in power. **I Cor.15:42, 43.**

*From mortality **to** immortality. So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory. **I Cor.15:54.**

*From Law **to** Grace. For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law but under grace. **Rom. 6:14.**

*From being covered in dross **to** refinement.

*From sin **to** become the servants of God. Now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life. **Rom 6:22.**

*From the power of Satan **to** the power of God. ...and from the power of Satan to the power of God, that they receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me. **Acts 26:18.**

*From not a people **to** Kings and Priest's.

...Unto Him that loved us and washed us from our sins in his own blood, hath made us Kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Rev.1:5-6.

In the New Testament, some of the From's and To's have the word **if** attached to them. If you take the: (if) out of these statements, you will find yourself relegated to law.
